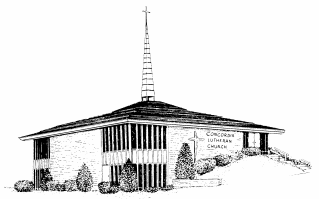

The Call package will be completed this week and hand carried to the Southeastern District Office on Wednesday, February 23rd.

**KEEPING INFORMED—Notes from the February 18 Planning Council Meeting**

**Executive Director**—Glen Krc At the special congregational meeting on Sunday February 21, the council agreed by consensus to provide information to the congregation on part 3 of the call document which contains the compensation information. The compensation package is in line with the budget approved by the congregation for 2010 and will not require another vote. /Glen referred council members to a section of a communication from Joel Fridgen concerning the need to explore ways to get the elevator installed. There are a number of individuals in the congregation who cannot handle stairs so the elevator has become a necessity.  
**Financial Secretary** - John Ramacciotti The operating income for the month of January was \$17,876.96 which is 129.2% of what it was at this time last year. / There was some discussion of the need for a “giving guide” – a letter or other means to advise new members of specific areas that they can contribute to financially at Concordia and how to facilitate the prompt and correct allocation of those contributions. This could be part of a new member “packet”

entry ways following the recent snowstorms. /The parking lots continue to be plowed by a local paving company who does it free of charge for Concordia and a number of other churches in the area. Cheryl suggested we consider giving the owner a letter of thanks and a monetary donation at the end of the season to help cover some of his expenses. /The properties committee has a meeting scheduled for March 23.

**Special Report** Vince Fertitta presented a proposal for installing the elevator to give access to the lower level of the church. The council agreed by consensus to present complete information to the congregation by February 28, in preparation for a vote to approve the project at a special congregational meeting set for March 14. Details in the report will include information on the following:

Three bids were obtained. >One of the three has very favorable conditions making the project feasible. >Several members are willing to make 10 year interest only loans with principal being repaid as funds become available. The interest rate would be 3%.> The required finishing of the elevator lobby on the lower level can be completed with phase 2 funds.

Complete minutes of all meetings are posted on the church business bulletin board after they have been reviewed by council.
