A WORD FROM THE DIRECTOR,

Beginning in the fall of 2007, Inshallah has grown from 20 singers to a core of 65 singers from Waterloo Lutheran Seminary and the wider ecumenical community. The choir is committed to singing songs from faith communities around the world and seeks to understand the contexts from which the songs originate. *Inshallah* is an Arabic word that means "God willing"; the name was chosen to honour the origin of the choir, where on a trip to the Holy Land in 2007 thirty people from WLS sang and prayed together and came home determined to continue this experience. Choir members find that singing global songs together is joy-filled and contemplative, personally renewing, worldview-altering, and inspires advocacy and mission.
